



BOLDON SCHOOL HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

We believe that it is in the best interests of all pupils that the school should work in partnership with the pupils' homes.

If such a partnership is to work successfully then the school, parents and pupils all need to make certain commitments.

School

The school, its governors, teachers and support staff will:

- Treat your child with dignity and respect at all times.
- Give your child the opportunity to benefit from an excellent education.
- Keep you informed on all aspects of our work and your child's progress.
- Set, mark and monitor homework and provide facilities for children to do homework after school.
- Arrange Parents' Evenings during which your child's progress can be discussed.
- Keep parents informed about school activities through regular letters home, bulletins and notices about special events.

Parents

As a parent I will:

- Ensure that my child attends school at the correct time, wearing correct uniform, on each day the school is open, unless the child is genuinely ill or has a reason for absence agreed in advance with the school.
- Attend Parents' Evenings and discussions about my child's progress.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour including the Code of Conduct.
- Support my child in doing homework and provide other opportunities for home learning.

- Let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour.

Pupils

As a pupil of Boldon School I will:

- Follow the school's Code of Conduct.
- Attend lessons on time, equipped with the correct books plus pen, ruler, pencil, rubber and other equipment required by the teacher.
- Undertake the work and activities the teachers' request and complete all homework and other tasks by the given date.
- Work to the very best of my abilities, co-operating with teachers and others in the school to achieve the very highest standards in all work undertaken.
- Treat all members of the school community with respect and dignity at all times and not engage in any bullying or violent behaviour.
- Respect the property of the school and of members of the school at all times.
